### DPW: Hardship Collection Service?

The Department of Public Works (DPW) provides hardship collection services for residents who are physically unable to place or return their garbage/recycling containers to their property. The trash/recycling crew will collect the containers from your storage location, empty, and return them to their storage location. There is an eligibility application that must be mailed or faxed, it is located at <https://dpw.dc.gov/service/hardship-collection-services>.

## 2018-2019 Leaf Collection

The fall leaf collection program runs from November 5 through January 19. Please rake your loose leaves into your tree box (or at the curb if no tree box) the Sunday before your scheduled collection week. Every street will have at least two scheduled collection weeks. Crews will only come once during each scheduled week. Residents may track the progress of DPW's leaf collection crews and view before and after photos of their work at <http://leaf.dpw.dc.gov/leafcollection/>.

Residents may also place bagged leaves where their trash/recycling is collected. Each year DPW collects and composts between five and seven thousand tons of loose leaves. Unfortunately, bagged leaves placed where your trash is collected are not able to be composted and will only be picked up as space in their trucks permits.

Please have your leaves ready for collection by the Sunday of each of your collection weeks. Residents should beware that the same crews that collect leaves also remove snow and ice, so leaf collection may be interrupted for snow or ice removal duties. Please report leaf-clogged catch basins or storm drains to DC Water at 202-612-3400.

For Fairlawn, the First Pass happened between Nov. 6th and 10th. Now, leaves ready by Dec. 16th, will be collected between Dec. 17th and 22nd.
