Education Scholarship Fund

The Fairlawn Citizens Association, Inc., Education Scholarship Fund is intended to provide financial support to high school students pursuing higher education. Successful applicants will receive \$1,000 per year for a maximum amount of \$4,000 per student. Awards will be deposited with the Office of the Bursar/Finance at the applicant's school of choice.

Eligibility Requirements:

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- Live in the boundaries of the Fairlawn community;
- Have a parent or guardian who has been an active member of the Fairlawn Citizens Association for at least one year prior to applying for a scholarship;
- Have at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale;
- Be a current high school senior planning to attend an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university program;
- Have a need for financial assistance.

Application Procedures:

Interested persons may apply by submitting a completed application form in an unfolded 9"x12" envelope postmarked no later than **May 1**. Please include the following information with the application:

- A written letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, community leader, or minister. The letter must be signed and submitted in a separate sealed envelope with the application;
- A double spaced typed essay of not less than 350 words on the topic: "Why Citizens Associations are Important to the Community".
- A list briefly describing awards, extracurricular and/or community service activities, and academic and future goals. Provide enough information so that the selection committee will know what you have done and what your plans are for the future.
- An official copy of your high school transcript.

Boundaries:

The boundaries of the Fairlawn Community are **East** on Fairlawn Avenue, SE, from the 11th Street Bridge to Pennsylvania Avenue, SE, **South** on Pennsylvania Avenue, SE, to 25th Street, SE, **West** on 25th Street, SE, to Naylor Road, SE, **South** on Naylor Road, SE, to Good Hope Road, SE, **North** on Good Hope Road, SE, to the 11th Street Bridge.
